

JOB TITLE: Product Manager – Technology Partner Products (TPP)

SUMMARY: This Product Manager position is primarily responsible for providing technology partner's products and services information to the UNICOM Engineering organization as required. Technology Partners includes but not limited to Dell, HP, Lenovo, Microsoft, etc. along with their computing hardware servers, services and software products. The Product Manager will work closely with Product Management, Field Application & Product Engineering Supply Chain Management, Project Management, and Sales & Marketing to win new business and grow existing business.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The organization's go to person for technology partner's products & services information.
- Establish and maintain Microsoft OS product repository on SharePoint; lifecycle status, roadmaps, downgrading, upgrading, licensing and provide the needed training.
- Establish and maintain Dell, HPE, Lenovo, etc. server product repository on SharePoint; lifecycle status, roadmaps and various support documents as required by the organization.
- Proactively communicate technology partner's products end of life status to the organization.
- Work with account managers & project managers with product transition plans down to the component level and configurations providing a 90/60/30 day outlook.
- Work with the IT department in managing the UNICOM Engineering Customer Portal, product presentations, documentations & demos, etc.
- Provide internal tool support for the quoting of technology partner's products.
- Develop & maintain process map for partner / supplier engagements.
- Learns about Company's business as appropriate. Shows up to work on time and attends work as scheduled.
- All other duties as requested by department head.
