SUMMARY:

The Senior Business Intelligence/ Data Warehouse Developer will be responsible for developing business intelligence and data warehouse solutions. This position will include providing technical leadership in developing the overall BI/DW database/ data management architecture and strategy, implementing and supporting the physical data models and providing guidance to IT management in establishing both a short-term roadmap and long-term BI/DW strategy. This position provides hands-on technical knowledge and leadership working with the Business Analysts, Infrastructure teams, Architects, and Developers in support of all BI/DW initiatives.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Architect, develop, and maintain data marts and data warehouses for large manufacturing company.
- Document data warehouse and ETL procedures, sources, and structures.
- Develop and oversee execution of ETL packages hybrid environment.
- Provide first line support in ETL and data issues.
- Develop and support end user report development and data extractions.
- Collaborate with the business units and other IT teams in delivering robust, high quality and effective BI/DW solutions.
- Learn about company's business as appropriate. Shows up to work on time and attends work as scheduled.
- All other duties as requested by supervisor or department head.
